



Who is worthy?




The rider on the white horse






An angel having the seal of the living God



The third trumpet – the star Wormwood poisoning the waters




The third parenthetical – announcement of three woes by a crying eagle




The eagle's second woe: – Demon-riders come out from the bottomless pit




The seventh trumpet - The beast out of the sea








Behold, the King is coming



The devastation at HarMagedon




